#### **Job Description:**

Under the overall supervision of the District Coordinator/Livelihood Officer, and guidance of Livelihood Focal Person from Deutsche Welthungerhilfe (DWHH), the CSA consultant/facilitator/resource person will be responsible to perform the following tasks and duties:

- With support of Livelihood focal person and consultation of DWHH technical person (FSL), review and prepare guidelines for the selection of lead farmers as CSA groups participants/ trainees
- Visit villages and meeting with lead farmers/participants, selected by Social organisers for capacity building sessions on climate smart agriculture (CSA) and Conservation Agriculture (CA) based technologies and practices.
- Identify themes for farmers capacity building and prepare session plans and all other relevant reference/reading material for capacity building sessions with the consultation of relevant line departments (Agriculture), FDO & DWHH Technical (FSL) experts.
- Identify women lead farmers for trainings and capacity building sessions as per defined criteria by Livelihood officer and Project Coordinator.
- Conduct/facilitate capacity building sessions as per session plans and support project team in attendance of beneficiaries, transport and food payments to beneficiaries and preparing a brief report of session.
- Conduct practical demonstration of lead farmers/participants on the demonstration plots of Rabi and Kharif season crops e.g. Wheat, vegetables, fodders, high value crops etc. Also keep close coordination with relevant experts from line departments, private sector and invite them to facilitate the sessions/demonstrations.
- Compile and keep record of all crops/demonstration plots agronomic data in soft and hard (starting from land preparation, seed sowing, till harvesting).
- Ensure the submission of capacity building sessions weekly, monthly work plan, seasonal (Rabi/Kharif) and final progress reports to the project coordinator.
- Perform any other associated duties as required by Project Coordinator or Livelihood Officer.
